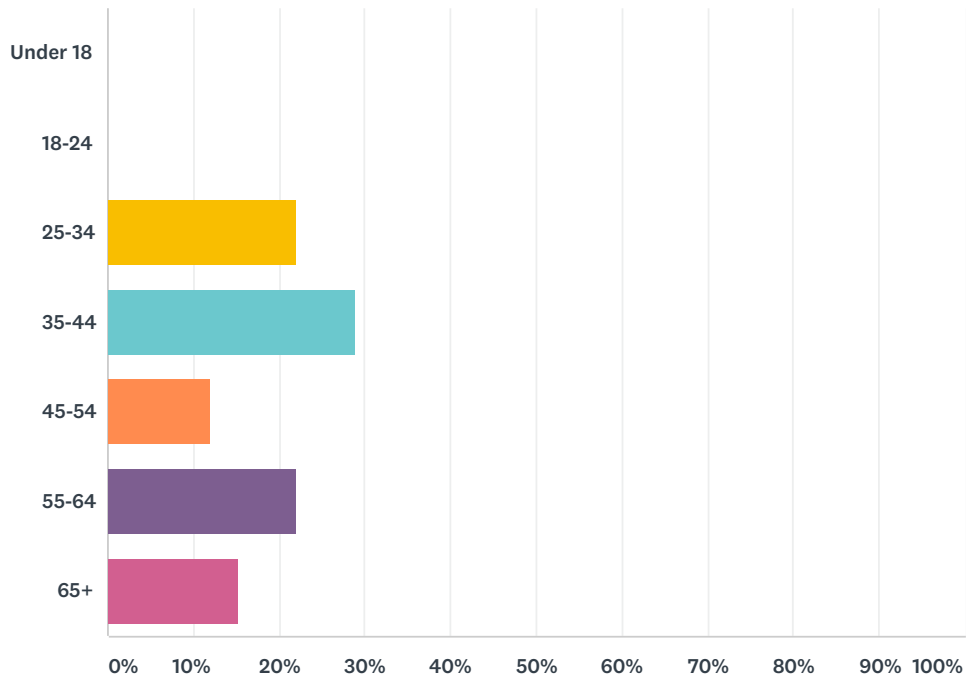

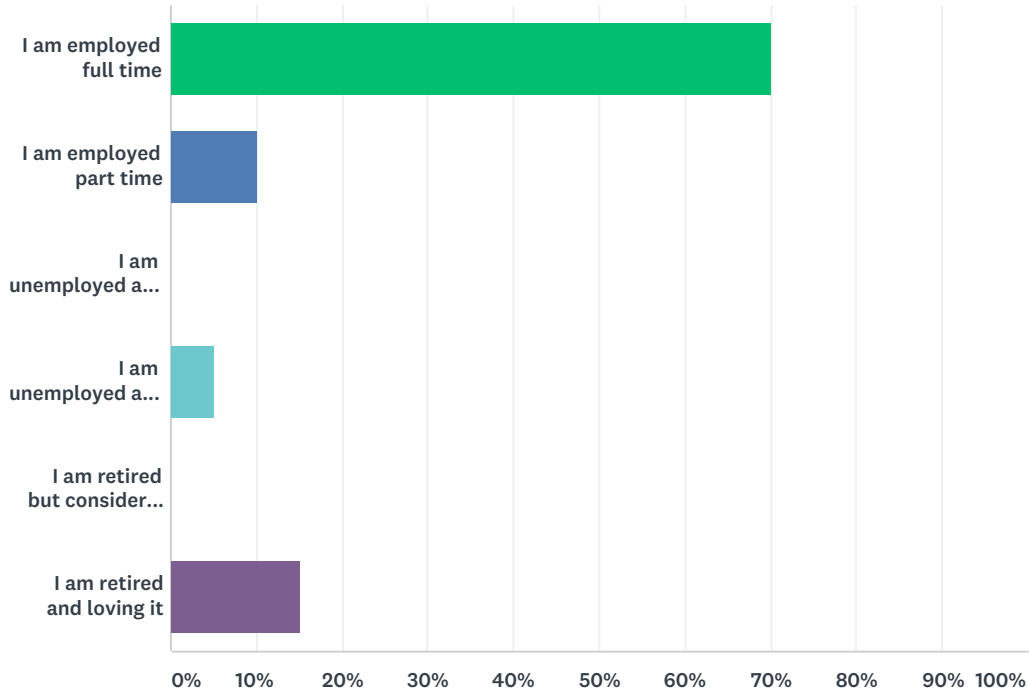

Q62 What is your current employment status?

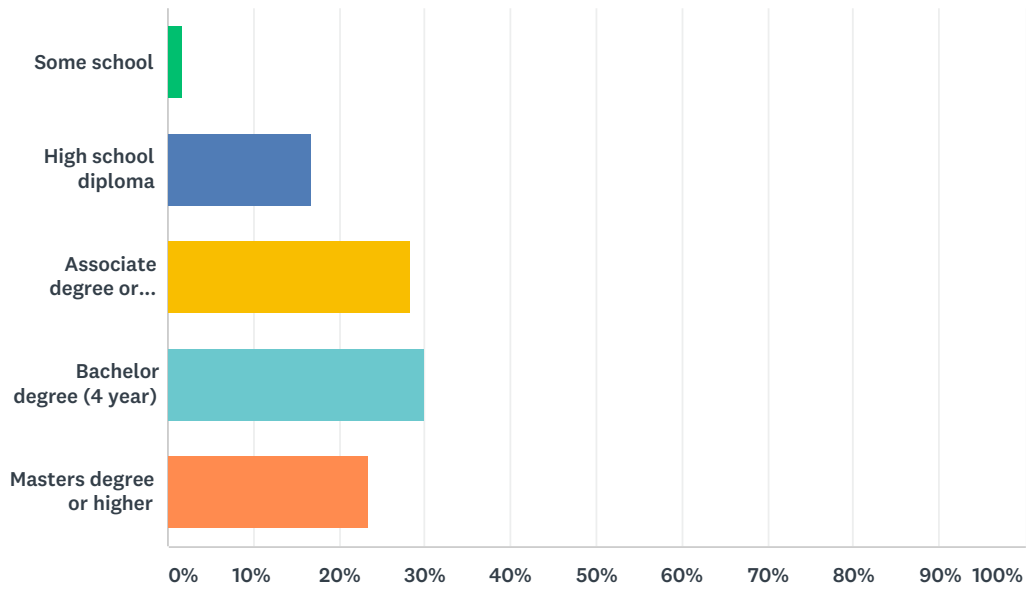

Q63 What is your highest level of education?

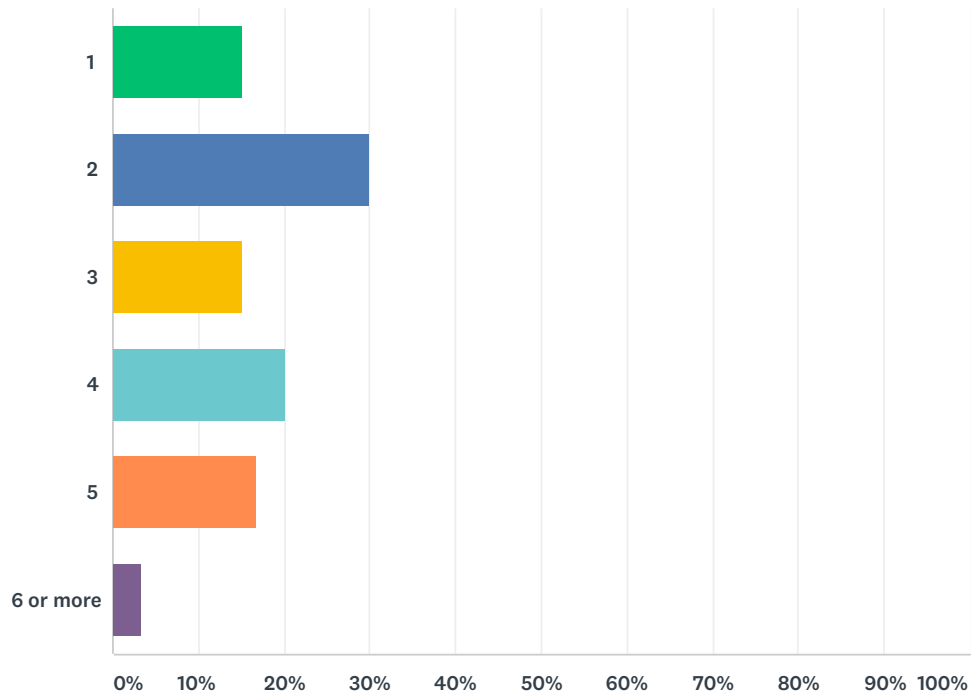

Q64 How many people are currently living in your household?

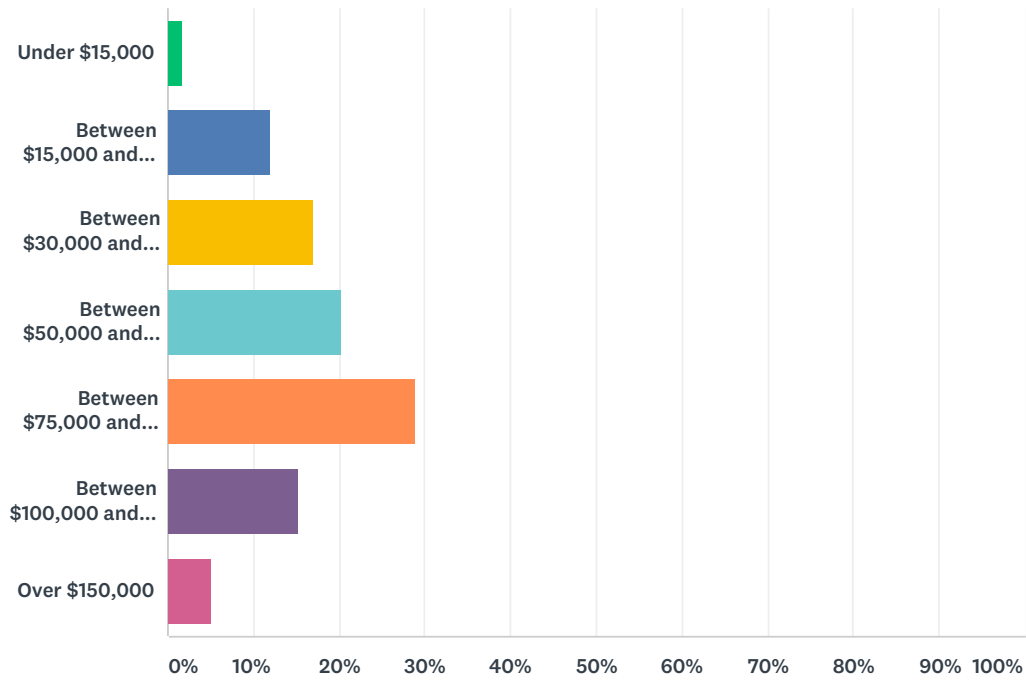

Q65 What is your approximate household income?

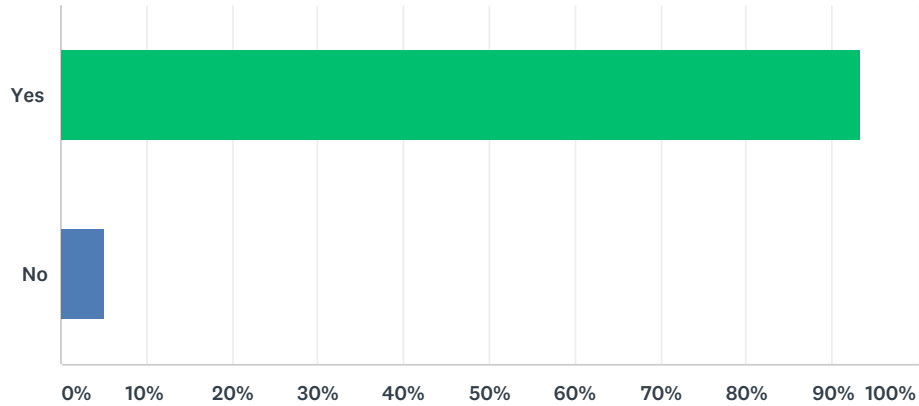

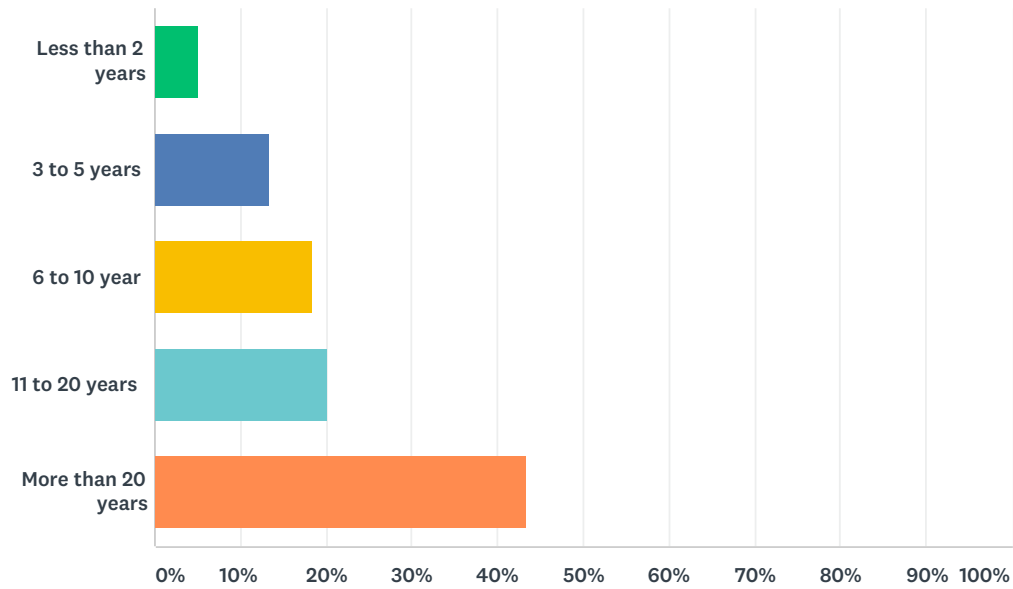

For what property taxes run in the city we don't have a lot to show for it! While having a college in our town is great, they bleed the community dry with all their fundraising. Q67 How long have you lived in the Mayville-Portland area?

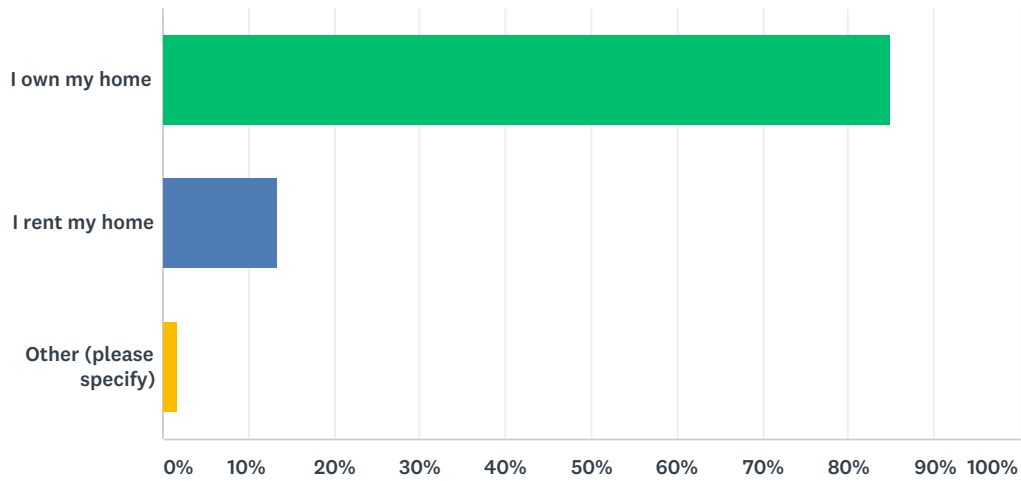

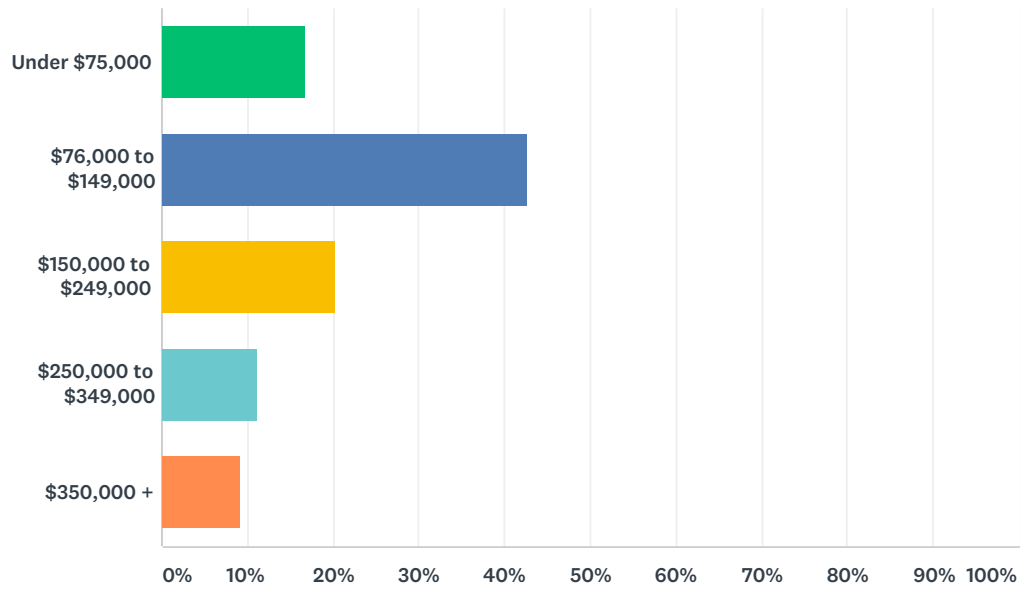

Q69 If you currently own, what is the approximate value of your home?

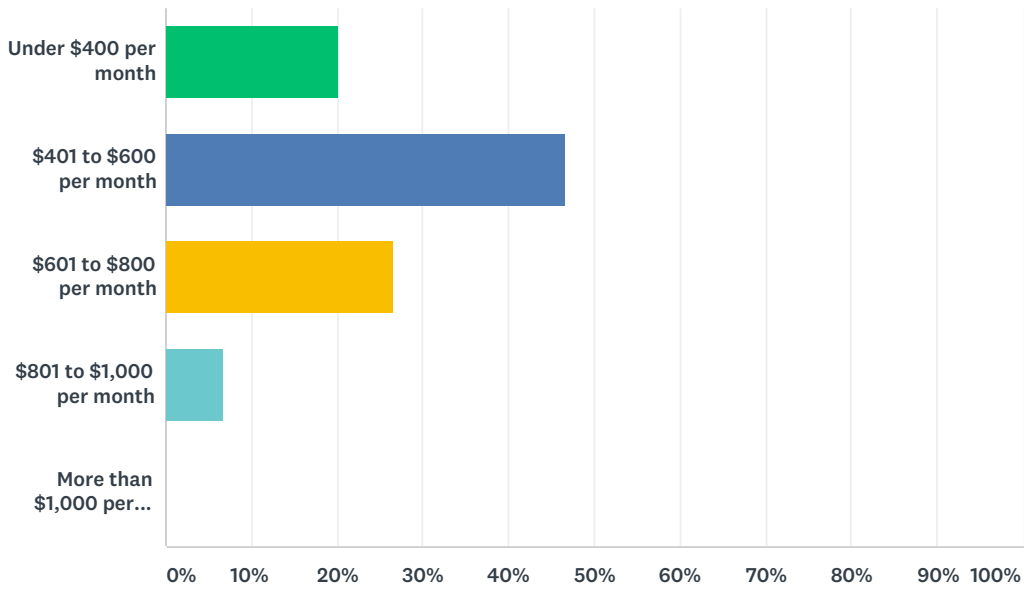

Q70 If you currently rent, about how much per month are you paying?

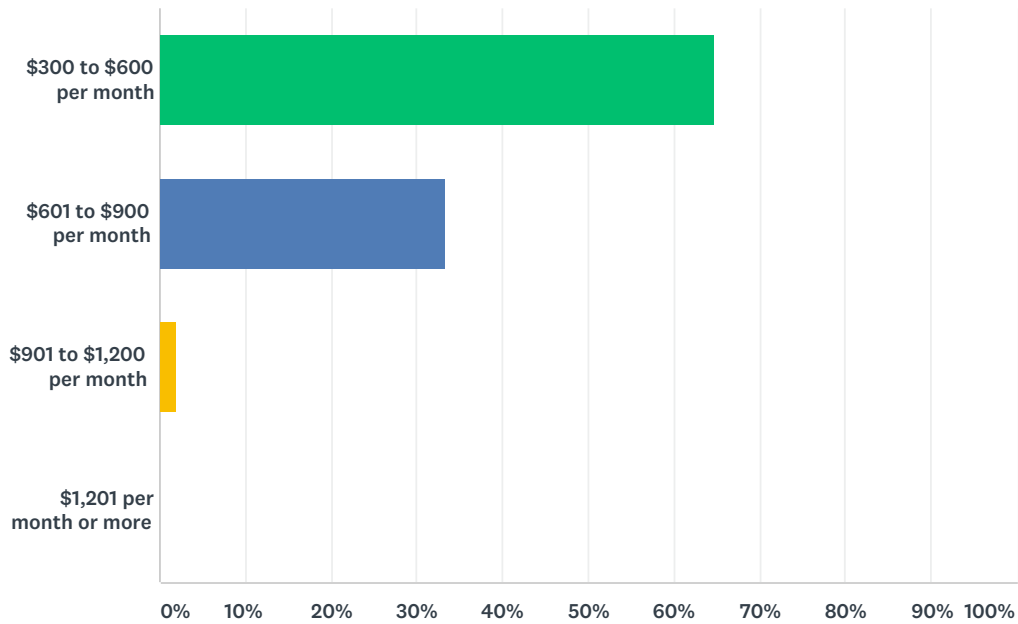

Q71 In YOUR OPINION - what is a reasonable price to pay to rent a place to live?

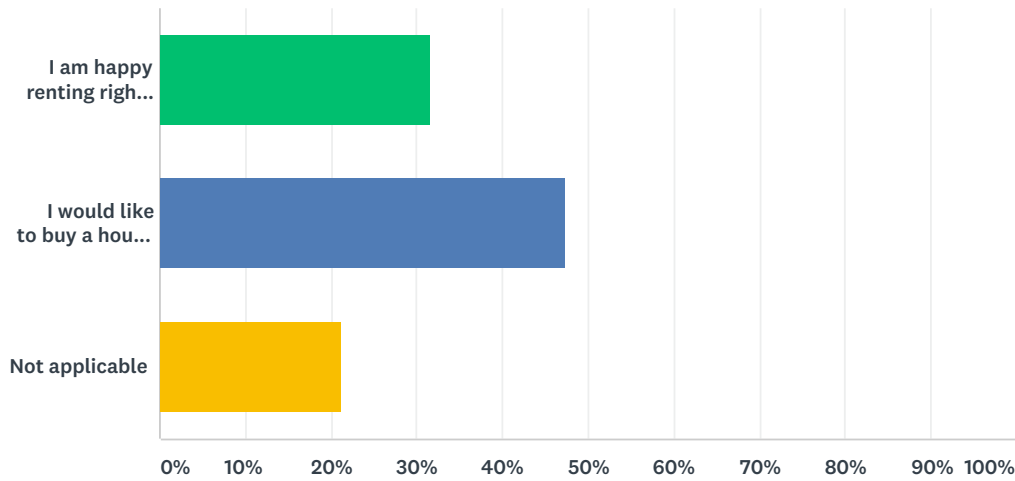

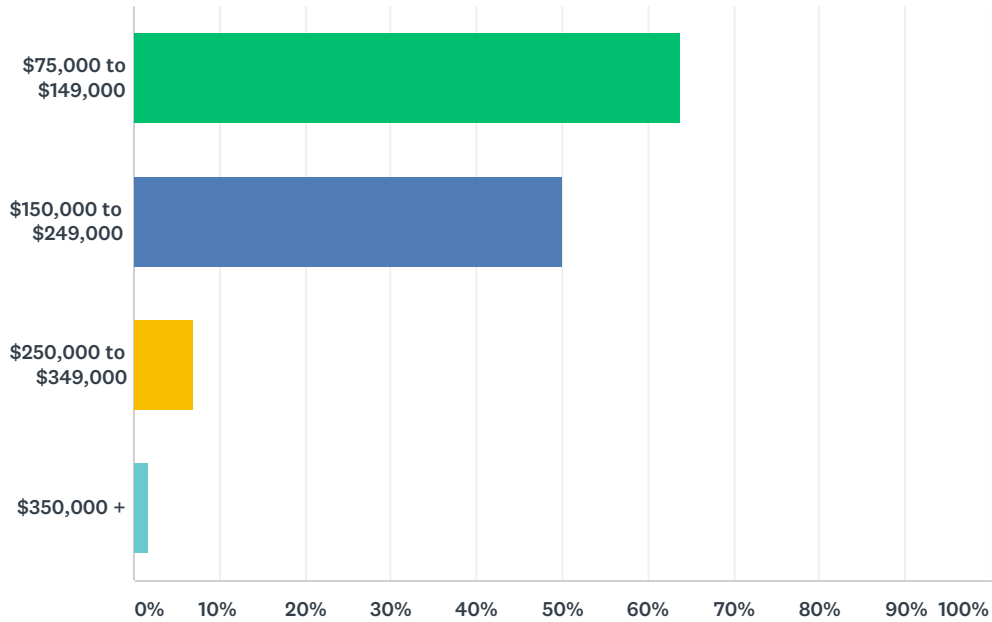

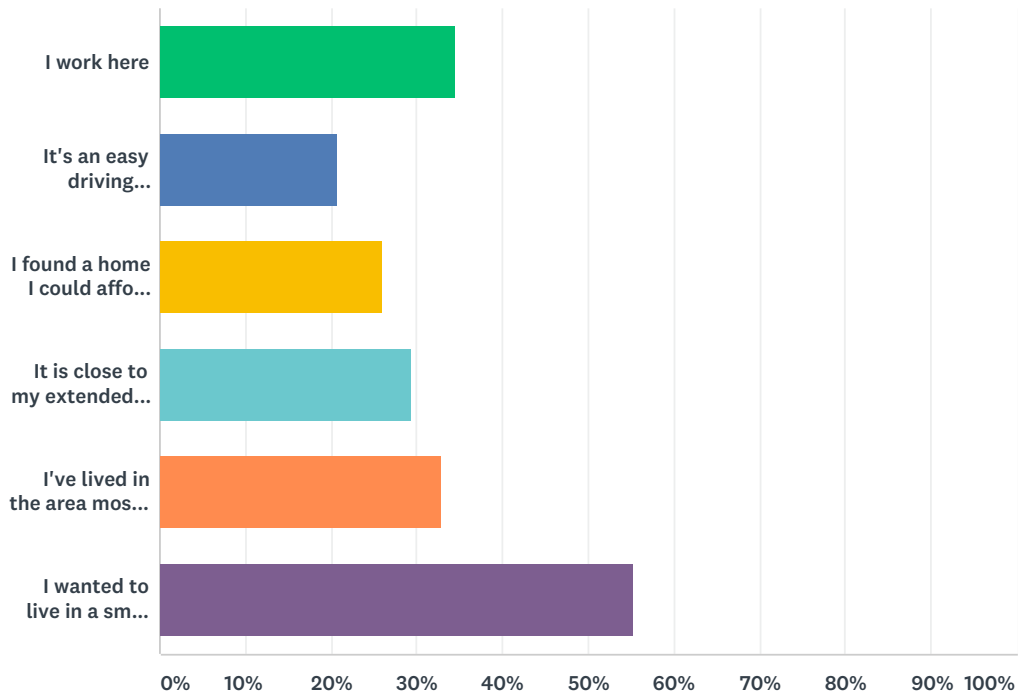
