Program Guidelines

Purpose: Provide financial assistance to Traill County, North Dakota primary sector

businesses for the purpose of workforce education and development, workforce expansion and retention, new hire training or hiring consulting firms to help

improve business processes and efficiencies.

Timeframe: Applications will be accepted until grant funds have been fully allocated for each

funding period.

Eligible Organizations: New or existing businesses in Traill County that have been certified as primary

sector businesses by the North Dakota Department of Commerce.

Grant Amount: Approved applicants are eligible for up to \$1,000 in per business per funding

period.

Evaluation Criteria: Funds will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis to qualifying businesses

and for allowed expenses.

Application Process: The financial request must include the Primary Sector Training Grant

application. The application can be downloaded at traillcountyedc.com. The

Other conditions: The following documentation must be submitted with the application:

Quote or price list for desired training, dates and name(s) of employee(s) who will receive training. Funds can be used for class or training registration fees, or to pay trainers. Grant funds cannot be used for travel-related expenses (hotel, meals, transportation, etc.). Funds must be used within 12 months of their

approval.

Funding Process: Funds will be provided once the training has been completed. Supporting

documentation, such as invoices or receipts and canceled checks or proof of

payment, as well as a copy of primary

sector certification from the North Dakota Dept. of Commerce, must be included.
