
Traill County EDC Public Spaces Grant







Program Guidelines

Purpose: Provide financial assistance to Traill County, N.D. political subdivisions, school

districts and other entities to create or update public spaces to create more vibrant, inviting and inclusive communities in which to retain and attract

residents of all ages.

Timeframe: Applications will be accepted through May 13, 2024. Applicants will be notified

of the status of their requests by May 24, 2024, and will have until Dec. 1, 2025

to complete the project and submit their paperwork.

Eligible organizations: Political subdivisions (e.g. cities, park boards) in Traill County and other

entities, including school districts, as long as the project is open and accessible

to the general public.

Grant amount: Approved applicants are eligible for up to \$5,000 in matching funds, with a

preference on no more than one grant award per city. This is a competitive grant

with a total allocation of \$15,000; not all projects will be funded.

Evaluation criteria: Applications will be reviewed on individual basis with preference given toward

overall project impact and viability. Applicant investment will be considered but

will not supersede community impact.

Application process: The financial request must include the Public Spaces Grant application. The

Other conditions: The following documentation must be submitted with the application:

Project proposal/specs (if available), budget and funding plan, detailed bids/

estimates, timeline, maintenance plan and photo of project site.

Funding process: Funds will be provided once the project has been completed, although letter of

support/financial guarantee of funds can be provided upon request to secure

matching funds. Supporting

documentation such as invoices or receipts and canceled checks or proof of payment must be included, along with

IRS Form W-9.
